No item larger than 36" x 36" will be accepted in this department. No item weighing more than 25 pounds will be accepted in this department. Awards will be made on quality of workmanship and originality of design. **ALL ENTRIES IN THE DESIGNER-CRAFTSMAN DEPARTMENT MUST BE ORIGINAL WORK; NO RIBBON WILL BE AWARDED TO ARTICLES MADE FROM KITS.**
