- Assist in content creation for social media platforms and BigTex.com;
- Assist in updating and tracking social media analytics across all channels;
- Execute social media sponsorship requirements;
- Provide a creative eye towards new and trending social content;
- Produce creative content following Fair branding guidelines;
- Ability to capture content if needed.
