ENTRY FEE: \$4.00 PER CLASS (A.K.A. CATEGORY)

Contestants are permitted to ENTER “THREE (3) CATEGORIES ONLY”. Each class/category entered must consist of “two (2)” items aged 30 years or older. “Exception” is “ANTIQUÉ” which MUST be 100 years or older and only “one (1)” item required. Pre-registration is required. An entry form and entry fee(s) must be received no later than July 25, 2014. Items can be “mailed in” with the entry form and entry fee in the same package & also must be received by July 25; “Or” delivered in person at a later date. See Entry Rules & Guidelines in front of book on hand delivery or mail delivery of items.

Previous “ribbon winners” or items which have been displayed at the State Fair of Texas will not be accepted a second time. **The State Fair WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGED, BROKEN AND/OR MISSING ITEMS. Edible substances will not be accepted.** The maximum size of an entry cannot exceed 18 inches long by 12 inches deep by 20 inches high unless otherwise pre-approved. No item weighing more than 10 lbs. will be accepted. Framed articles shall consist of no more than two (2) items per frame.
