

Frequently Asked Questions 2015

1. When are entry deadlines?
 - a. Youth Shows, August 25 by midnight ONLINE
 - b. Pan American, September 1
 - c. Youth Contest, September 15
 - d. Rabbits and Poultry, September 15
2. As an exhibitor, can I enter into youth shows?
 - a. NO, an FFA Advisor or County Extension Agent is only eligible to enter exhibitors into youth shows by logging in as a club with your 5 digit zip code.
3. Are summary forms required?
 - a. YES, all youth livestock shows AND contests require a summary form AND a \$15 processing fee.
 - b. If both summary forms are submitted together you are only required to pay the processing fee one time.
4. Are all exhibitors required to submit an entry certification/indemnity and W-9?
 - a. YES
5. Where can I locate the Breeding Gilt Show Entry Application?
 - a. The Junior Breeding Gilt Show has been incorporated in the Pan American Entry Application.
 - b. This also includes the Swine Skill-a-Thon
6. How will I receive purchased and complimentary passes prior to the State Fair of Texas?
 - a. REQUIRED: \$15 processing fee for youth show will guarantee certified mail delivery to the CEA/AST prior to the fair starting
 - b. OPTIONAL: \$8 processing fee for Pan American and Junior shows will guarantee certified mail delivery to the exhibitor
7. Where do I upload my public speaking or job interview information?
 - a. All additional contest material must be uploaded to judgingcard.com
8. What shows require validation?
 - a. ALL Youth Market Shows
 - b. Youth Breeding Heifers
9. Do breeding gilts have to be validated?
 - a. NO
10. Where do I mail hard copies (summary forms (if applicable), worksheets, entry applications, W-9, entry certification/indemnity and payment)?
