BIG TEX GOLF CLASSIC BACKGROUND AND PROCEEDS

The State Fair of Texas Chairman's Task Force is pleased to present the 5th Annual Big Tex Golf Classic. Proceeds from this year's tournament will benefit the State Fair Youth Scholarship Program.

The State Fair Youth Scholarship Program is open to eligible high school seniors who participate in State Fair livestock shows and to outstanding students attending the following Fair Park-area high schools: Lincoln, James Madison, North Dallas, Woodrow Wilson and the Irma L. Rangel Young Women's Leadership School.

ABOUT THE STATE FAIR OF TEXAS

Since its inception in 1886, the State Fair of Texas has celebrated all things Texan by promoting agriculture, education, and community involvement through quality entertainment in a family-friendly environment. The State Fair of Texas is a non-profit organization with all proceeds helping to preserve and improve Fair Park and underwrite museum, community and scholarship programs for inner city youth and students pursuing agricultural careers. The 2015 exposition runs September 25 through October 18 in Fair Park.

The State Fair of Texas is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, and does not receive any government funding or support. Its nonprofit purpose is funded through the proceeds from the annual State Fair of Texas event. The net proceeds from the Fair are reinvested in Fair Park, in the form of capital improvements; given as scholarships to deserving youth throughout the state of Texas; used to support the Fair Park museum facilities and community outreach programs; and used to improve the State Fair's operation.

TIME. PLACE. AND FORMAT

The tournament is being held at the the Old American Golf Club on Monday, September 14, 2015. Registration begins at 11a. Carts will leave at 12:45p. The tournament will start promptly at 1p. The tournament format is a 4-person scramble.

LUNCH AND DINNER

Lunch and dinner are complimentary. Lunch will begin at 11a. Dinner will begin at completion of play.

MULLIGAN / RAFFLE

Mulligan tickets cost \$50 each. An accompanying prize with a value of at least \$50 comes with each mulligan. One mulligan per player. A separate raffle will be held at the tournament dinner. Raffle tickets will be available for purchase at registration and prior to the start of the raffle. Must be present to win.

RAIN POLICY

Given the tournament's charitable nature and dependency on weather, there are no refunds of any kind. Unless the golf course prohibits play due to rain, the tournament will be played. If the golf course prohibits play, then the tournament will be rescheduled by tournament personnel.
