5 WILD WEST PET PALOOZA

The Wild West Pet Palooza, featuring Joel Slaven's Professional Animals, includes an array of comical skits starring animals that have been rescued from shelters across the nation. Boasting an impressive cast of critters ranging from cats and dogs to pigs and porcupines, this show is full of family fun.

6 VISIT OLLIE THE OAK TREE

You'll want to stay and not leaf; look up in amazement at our environmentally friendly 12-foot-tall mystical tree. Located outside the Errol McKoy Greenhouse on the Midway, our chatty green friend doesn't stay planted for long.

7 PET A STINGRAY AT THE CHILDREN'S AQUARIUM

With interactive exhibits for hands-on exploration, this kid-friendly facility offers a coastal touch pool and daily stingray feedings, along with up-close views of sharks, piranhas, alligators, sea turtles and more!

8 MIDWAY BARKER

Don't miss this hoot of a performance! The Barker entertains Midway crowds with his antics and jabs – all in good fun. A funny-bone tickler!

9 PLAY ALONG AT THE PEE WEE STAMPEDE AND RODEO

The Pee Wee Stampede and Rodeo lets kiddos put on a show and participate in mock rodeo events. While the crowd cheers, the kids race on their stick horses and bulls and provide a fun-filled show for everyone. From bronco busting to barrel racing, kids are the stars of this rodeo. You can't miss this laugh-out-loud production! Suitable for children four to eight years old.

10 WORLD ON A STRING

Kids love this cast of marionettes produced by a master puppeteer. Running 25 minutes, this show features dancing boots, swimming fish, square dancers, skeletons, flamingos and more, all with a Texas theme!

11 LITTLE HANDS ON THE FARM

Kids love this fun and interactive exhibit where they learn how food gets from farm to table. Activities on this miniature farm include planting seeds, gathering eggs and driving a tiny tractor before harvesting crops and taking them to market. With the earnings from sold crops, snacks can be purchased in the General Store. Suitable for toddlers to eight years old.
