



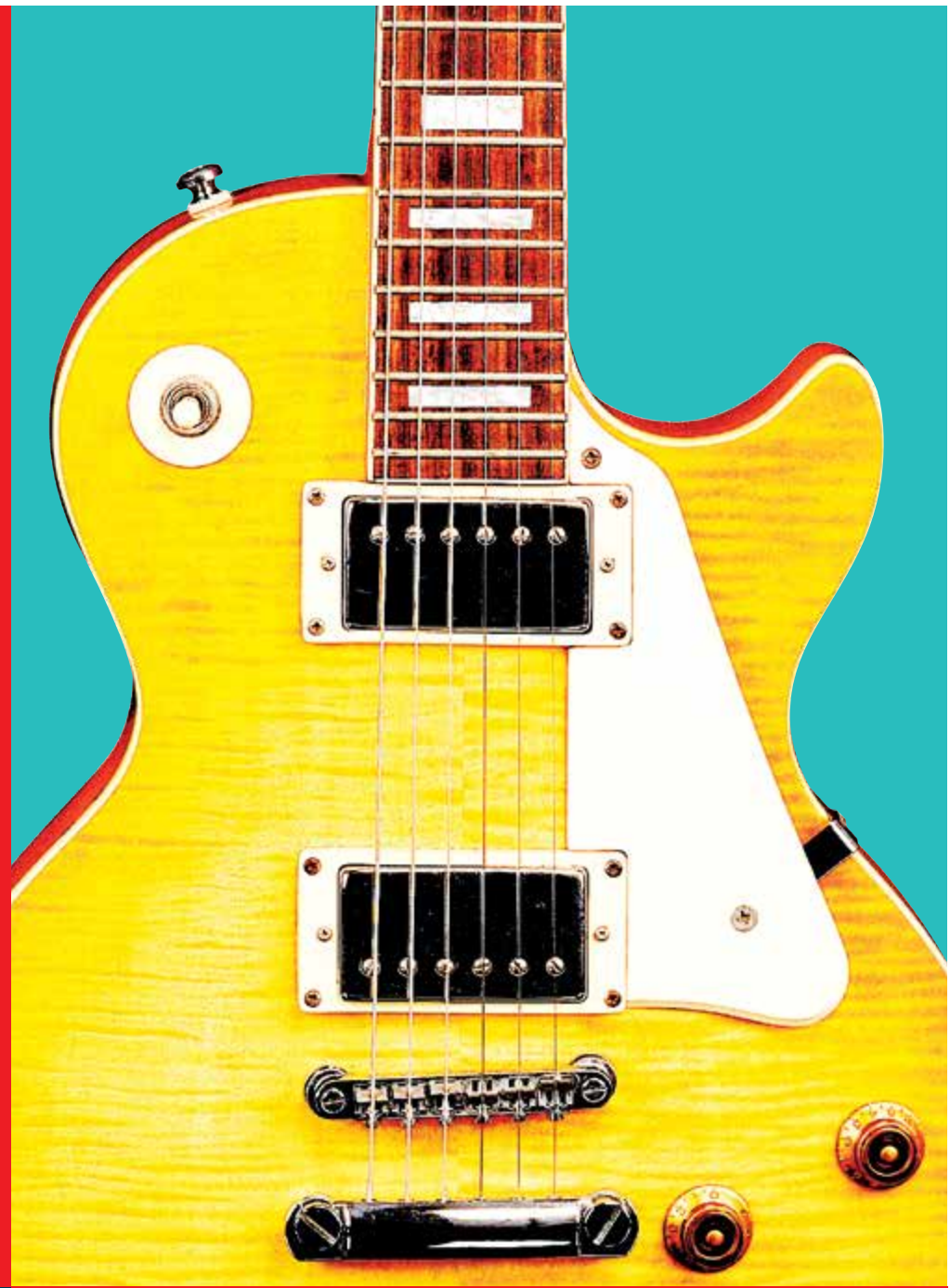

## 1 IKEBANA EXHIBIT

Ikebana is the Japanese art of arranging flowers. Witness an ornate variety of floral arrangements on display at the Texas Discovery Garden from the Ikebana International Dallas Chapter. While there, be sure to visit the Tropical Butterfly House and Snakes of Texas exhibit.

## 2 MOVING DALLAS

Commissioned by VisitDallas, this exhibit showcases the art photographs and film that juxtapose Dallas' world-class dance performers with the city landscape. Moving Dallas is seventh in an award-winning collection of works by the London-based film-maker Jevan Chowdhury to capture the world as a stage. Life on the street in London, Paris, Brussels, Prague, Yerevan and Athens has been recorded in this growing canon, titled Moving Cities.

## 3 TEXAS IN THE FIRST WORLD WAR

"Texas in the First World War" provides an in-depth look into Lone Star State history, exploring the active roles that both Texas and the United States played throughout the pivotal war era. Displaying a collection of wartime memorabilia and vehicles such as a Model T

ambulance and a 1917 Indian motorcycle, the exhibit also incorporates details of the significant "Punitive Expedition" and the operation's influences leading up to America's involvement in WWI.

## 4 XPOGO

Catch this extreme sports show, featuring two pogo professionals showing off their skills with gravity-defying tricks, flips and spins.

## 5 ZUZU AFRICAN ACROBATS

Performing along the scenic Esplanade reflecting pool, the ZuZu African Acrobats show off their amazing acrobatic skills on the Mattress Firm Stage. This group of well-orchestrated team members comprises a gymnastic spectacle and takes the limbo to a new level.

## 6 GUERRERO - MEXICO: ITS ARTISTRY, FOLKLORE, & MAJESTIC TREASURES

Mundo Latino presents 24 days of performances, shopping, exhibits and culinary experiences celebrating the famous Guerrero state of Mexico. Families, students and art lovers alike will all be immersed into the world of Guerrero, its artistry, folklores and majestic treasures.

## 7 STATE FAIR OF TEXAS BUTTER SCULPTURE

Among the blue ribbon-winning contest entries displayed throughout the Creative Arts Building lies an equally unique creation - the State Fair Butter Sculpture. The talented Ken Robison returns to create this year's butter sculpture masterpiece, based on the 2017 theme "Celebrating Texans." The sculpture, made from approximately 1,000 pounds of butter, showcases traditional Texas personas representing all things Texan. These include our urban life, agricultural roots, educational advancements, and our rich history; with faces carved into quintessential Texas landmarks.

## 8 LIVE MUSIC ON THE DR PEPPER STAGE

On Nimitz Circle next to the Creative Arts Building you will find the Dr Pepper Stage, offering an eclectic mix of musical talent and a quaint grassy area to relax with your friends and family. Featuring all-new acts in 2017, the Dr Pepper Stage plays host to Kadie Lynn Roberson, Kevin Bailey Band, Blane Howard, and Maggie Baugh.

## 9 MAJESTY OF THE HORSE

Join renowned horseman Jerry Diaz for an intimate presentation displaying the majesty and beauty of the horse. The presentation includes multiple breeds (10 - 15) of horses and showcases their unique color, size and purpose.

## 10 ENJOY A CONCERT AT THE BUD LIGHT SOUND STAGE

Centrally located in Cotton Bowl Plaza, the Bud Light Sound Stage is convenient to all your Fair food favorites and features a wide variety of local and regional acts - all included with admission to the Fair. The 2017 lineup ranges from Tejano to classic country, with performances from the Tejas Brothers, Coffey Anderson, Chubby Carrier & the Bayou Swamp Band, and Vince Vance and the Valiants.
