

6 WILD WEST PET PALOOZA

The Wild West Pet Palooza, featuring Joel Slaven's Professional Animals, includes an array of comical skits starring animals that have been rescued from shelters across the nation. Boasting an impressive cast of critters ranging from cats and dogs to pigs and porcupines, this show is full of family fun.

VISIT SHORTY MCKOY,THE TINIEST TEXAS COWBOY

This 17-inch cowboy puppet interacts with kiddos, entertaining guests with singing, dancing and joke-telling.

PET A STINGRAY AT THE CHILDREN'S AQUARIUM

With interactive exhibits for hands-on exploration, this kid-friendly facility offers a coastal touch pool and daily stingray feedings, along with up-close views of sharks, piranhas, alligators, sea turtles and more!

9 RIDE THE DENTZEL CAROUSEL

The beautifully-crafted Dentzel Carousel remains one of the most popular rides at the State Fair of Texas. The merry-go-round, first built in 1914, features hand-carved wooden horses and chariots. The Carousel is one of the main attractions located on the Kidway.

10 PLAY ALONG AT THE PEE WEE STAMPEDE AND RODEO

The Pee Wee Stampede & Rodeo lets kiddos put on a show and participate in mock rodeo events. While the crowd cheers, the kids race on their stick horses and bulls and provide a fun-filled show for everyone. From bronco busting to barrel racing, kids are the stars of this rodeo. You can't miss this laugh-out-loud production! Suitable for children four to eight years old.

10 WORLD OF MAGIC SHOW

Featuring award-winning illusionists and futuristic elements that captivate people of all ages, "World of Magic" showcases a display of neon lighting, lasers, and even a floating robot!

12 LITTLE HANDS ON THE FARM

Kids love this fun and interactive exhibit where they learn how food gets from farm to table. Activities on this miniature farm include planting seeds, gathering eggs and driving a tiny tractor before harvesting crops and taking them to market. With the earnings from sold crops, snacks can be purchased in the General Store. Suitable for toddlers to eight years old.
