2017 RULES AND ENTRY GUIDELINES

We invite all amateurs to enter items for competition and awards in any department or contest listed in this Handbook. We invite **Teachers and Professionals** to enter Photography only in the appropriate categories.

Children and juniors are invited to enter designated classes according to their age, as listed below.

Children 6 - 11 years of age
Junior 12 – 17 years of age
Adult 18+ years of age
Seniors 70+ years of age

• PRE-FAIR CONTESTS

Arts, crafts and canning competitions are listed in the first half of the Handbook. These are entered early to be judged, with winning items used to decorate our showcases.

- Previous ribbon winning items displayed at the State Fair of Texas cannot be entered a second time.
- > All handmade articles must be made by one individual, with the exception of: a 2 person quilt or a group quilt.

FAIR-TIME CONTESTS

Contests are listed in the second half of the Handbook, which includes cooking contests conducted during the Fair.

- Bring your prepared item(s) ready for judging on the morning of the contest to the Home Depot® Contest Kitchen, located inside the Creative Arts Building.
- Contestants may register the morning of the contest with an absolute deadline of 10:30am.
- Doors open by 9am every day except Opening Day, 9-29-17, which opens at 10am.
- 5 Cook-Offs include 16 contestants only and require advance registration to participate. Participants are chosen by lotto drawing. See each cook-off contest page for rules.

SECURITY

Security is provided during building hours. Every precaution is taken to protect all articles.

- Any insurance deemed necessary by an exhibitor must be provided by that individual.
- It is distinctly understood, that in no case, shall the State Fair of Texas®, its directors, officers or employees be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any character to any person, animal, vehicle, art work, exhibit or article, while participating in the Creative Arts Department at the State Fair of Texas®.

PRE-FAIR REGISTRATION AND TAKE-IN OF ITEMS

We now offer ON-LINE registration, which can be found on our website: www.bigtex.com. Deadline for pre-fair registration, along with payment, is Friday, July 21, 2017.

There are two different ways to register your item(s).

- ON-LINE REGISTRATION complete entry form & submit payment.
 - Items can then be mailed in and received by July 21, 2017. Include entry receipt.
 - OR bring your items in to Creative Arts on August 11, 12, 13, 2017.
- MAIL-IN REGISTRATION use entry form located at the back of this handbook or you can use the entry form located on our website.
 - Include entry form and entry fees.

There are two different ways to submit your actual item(s) to Creative Arts.

- MAIL ITEM(S) July 21, 2017 deadline for items mailed in.
 - Include a copy of your registration form and return postage either in the form of prepaid postage, stamps, check or money order. Your item will then be returned by mail at the conclusion of the fair.
 - NOTE: If mailing by post office, you must use our P.O. Box, listed on the entry form.
 - NOTE: If mailing by FEDEX or UPS, you must use our physical address, listed on the entry form.
- HAND DELIVER ITEMS August 11, 12, 13, 2017, 9am to 5pm.
 - Bring entry item(s), along with your registration receipt to the Creative Arts building on the dates specified above.
 - If you have not received your registration receipt, bring the items in anyway, as we will have you in our computer.

Checks or money orders should be made out to State Fair of Texas. All returned or NSF checks will be subject to a \$40.00 fee.

Senior Citizens (age 70+) pay a lesser fee of \$2.00 per entry in any contest.

Please include a phone number and email address on registration form in case we need to call or email.

JUDGING – PRE-FAIR

Judging will begin after August 13th, which is the final day that hand delivered items will be accepted.

- Entries are judged on individual merit and will place as judges deem fitting.
- Exhibitors will be notified by email or post office mail, as to the status of their entry.
- Winning entries will be displayed in our building until the fair is over.
- Non-winning entries can be picked up before the Fair begins on designated days. (See below)
- Mailed in entries will be stored and returned after the Fair is over, which may take as long as 3 weeks.
- We prefer not to return packages COD because costs are too high. We use your prepaid postage or stamps to return your items.
 - Exception: Mailed in photos do not require postage and will be returned at no extra charge.
 - Hand delivered photos must be picked up.

Note: If you have winners and non-winners, you may prefer to pick up all after the Fair. We will store any non-winners for you.

POST FAIR ALL REMAINING ENTRIES

Wednesday	October 25	Noon - 5pm
Thursday	October 26	9 am - 5pm
Friday	October 27	9 am - 7pm

Note: If items are not picked up at these designated times, you will need to make arrangement to pick up items on Monday, October 30. Anything remaining after that will incur a \$10 late fee.

BEST COMPETITOR AWARD

This is awarded to the Fair-Time Competitors who accumulate the most points earned during Fair Time.

1st Place - \$100

2nd Place - \$50

3rd Place - \$25

Points are awarded for Fair-Time contests only and are calculated as follows:

> Best of Show Purple Ribbon 4 points 1st Place Blue Ribbon 3 points 2nd Place Red Ribbon 2 points 3rd Place White Ribbon 1 point

Award Ceremony will be held following the final contest on Sunday, October 23, 2017.

Note: The 2017 First Place-Best Competitor will not be eligible to compete for this award in 2018.

DIRECTOR'S AWARD

The Director of Creative Arts / Special Events will select one Pre-Fair entry representing the outstanding creativity of all 2017 exhibitors. A special ribbon will be awarded and displayed on the item during the Fair.

DEFINITIONS

AMATEUR: A person who engages in an event or activity as a pastime rather than a profession.

CLASS: A group of like exhibits (ENTRY ITEMS) that are judged together, a sub-category of a department, same as lot.

CLASS NUMBER: The number assigned to each class or lot.

DEPARTMENT: A generalized category of exhibits (ENTRY ITEMS) or a group of classes / lots.

ENTRY ITEM: An eligible exhibit which is entered and judged.

EXHIBITOR: The owner of the exhibit (ENTRY ITEM) as shown on the entry form.

EXHIBITOR NUMBER: A permanent number that is assigned each person entering the Creative Arts Department of the fair.

HANDBOOK: A book that contains rules and regulations regarding entry in the Creative Arts Department of the fair.

LOT: Same as a class.

RULE BOOK: Same as handbook.

PROFESSIONAL: A person who engages in an event or activity for monetary profit (& earns more than \$2,000 per year), a person who teaches and / or instructs a particular craft or skill (i.e. sewing, needlework, baking, and so on). In Photography, a professional photographer uses photography to earn money; amateur photographers take photographs for pleasure and to record an event, emotion, place or person.

Any person who has edited, produced, printed and published a cookbook for individual gain will not be eligible to compete.

- Please read # B "DELIVERY/TAKE-IN OF ENTRY ITEMS" in the front of this handbook on page 9 for submission dates.
- All articles entered in competition in the Holiday Corner Department must have been completed by the exhibitor within the last two years.
- No soiled articles will be accepted.
- All classes are for single items. No multiples or pairs; unless otherwise stated.
- No ceramics, plastic canvas or Polymer Clay will be accepted in this
 department.
- No item weighing more than 25 pounds will be accepted.
- No item larger than 42" x 38" x 24" will be accepted.
- No free standing item over 30" high.
- No Wreaths wider than 30" maximum/diameter.
- Articles for hanging must be properly equipped with hooks, wire and/or brackets. Pipe cleaners cannot be used for hangers.
- Edible substances not accepted on items entered.
- Holiday Corner entries will be judged on originality of design, eye appeal and workmanship.
- The State Fair will not be responsible for any damaged, broken and/or missing items.
