**SHOW REQUIREMENTS**

- RULES/REGULATIONS:** Entries made in this department shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the General Rules and Regulations of the State Fair of Texas. National Miniature Donkey Association rules will govern Miniature Donkey classes according to the current NMDA rulebook. All Miniature Donkeys must be registered prior to the show. A copy of miniature registration papers (or a certified registration number issued by ADMS) **MUST** be sent in with the entry forms.
- ENTRY APPLICATION/FEE:** An entry application and fee of \$15 per class, plus a \$2 per Miniature Donkey fee along with all stall fees must be submitted by mail on or before **JULY 5, 2019**. All fees must be mailed in with applications and signature forms (W-9 and release of liability). Late entries will be accepted until August 4 at check in. Late entry fees will be equal to two times the regular class entry fees. Classes may be added on an animal already entered for \$15 per class.
- MUST HAVE IN HAND WHEN ENTERING THE FAIRGROUNDS;**  
**In State Equine**---Must have a negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test also known as "Coggins Test issued within 12 months.  
**Out of State Equine**---Must have a negative EIA Test (Coggins) and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days or a valid Equine Interstate Passport issued within 6 months.
- Get of Sire** entries **MUST** be entered on a separate entry form under the name of the sire. Offspring **MUST** also be entered in their appropriate halter classes.
- Produce of Dam** entries **MUST** be entered on a separate entry form under the name of the dam. Offspring **MUST** also be entered in their appropriate halter classes.
- Team Driving Teams **MUST** be entered on a separate entry form and their points **ONLY** count for team points.
- NO SMOKING** allowed in any barn, judging pavilion or coliseum.
- STALLS:** Stall fee of \$25/night per stall (including tack stalls). **LIMIT TWO (2) MINIATURES PER STALL**
- BEDDING:** Shavings may be purchased at check-in, on your entry form or you may bring your own shavings. Only bagged or baled wood shavings or chips may be used as bedding. One bag of shavings will be furnished for each purchased stall.

10. **FEED/HAY:** Feed grains of all types, along with several kinds of hay, will be available, at reasonable prices, through the State Fair of Texas Feed Office. Exhibitors can bring feed, bedding or hay onto the grounds.
11. **DRESS CODE.** Miniature donkey exhibitors must follow NMDA guidelines.
12. **YOUTH CLASSES:** NMDA youth classes are 17 years and younger. CANNOT show a jack 2 years or older. Must wear a hard hat in all driving classes. 12 years & under MUST have a knowledgeable adult in the cart with them for all driving classes.
  - a. Youth (if showing more than one donkey) must declare which donkey is going to count for high point at this show and for NMDA year end high point.
13. If both an adult and a youth are showing the same animal, you must declare at check-in who is going to show at halter for points. You cannot wait until after the show starts.
14. **DRUGS:** All animals are subject to drug testing. No person shall be permitted to administer internally or externally to any animal, either before or during an event. Any medication, drug, mechanical device or artificial appliance which is of such character, as it could affect its performance or appearance in that event is prohibit.
15. If at any time during the show an animal appears to be lame, sick, etc. (by the show committee or judge). It will be disqualified for the remainder of the show.
16. **No personal practice obstacles are allowed on the grounds.**
17. **TIES:** High point ties will be broken by the number of first places, then by number of animals placed over, then by number of classes placed in, then by the highest placing in Pleasure Driving (or in hand and trail for Non-Driving Divisions).
18. **HIGH POINT CALCULATION:** For classes of five or more animals, first place will receive 5 points, with the remaining places receiving one less point in descending order. For classes of less than six animals, first place will receive points equal to the number in the class, with the remaining places receiving one less point in descending order. NMDA Classes will receive a maximum of 5 points for 5 animals or more.
19. **AWARDS:** Premiums will be paid out post event, see schedule below. Trophy buckles will be given to High Point Youth, Green Adult and Open Adult Champions. Special Awards will be given to all Champions and Reserve Champions in the Halter divisions and to the Champion and Reserve Champion Teams, Pre-Green Adult, Non-Driving Green and Open Adult, Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, Best of Breed and Reserve High Point Youth, Green and Open Adult.
