ENTERING AN ARTS & CRAFTS CONTEST IS AS EASY AS...

- 1 CHOOSE A CONTEST**
The Fair has 14 different contests ranging from photography to scale models.
- 2 PICK A CATEGORY**
Each contest has a variety of different categories that target different age groups and crafting skills.
- 3 REGISTER ONLINE**
Simply go to www.BigTex.com/Creative and find the registration button to register your creative masterpiece(s).
- 4 DROP YOUR ENTRIES OFF**
All entries must be dropped off at the Creative Arts Building in Fair Park between **Friday, August 2, 2024** and **Sunday, August 4, 2024**, for judging. Winning entries will be announced via email on **August 21, 2024** and displayed in the Creative Arts Building during the run of the Fair. Contestants will pick up any non-winning entries before the Fair and winning entries will be picked up after the Fair.

WHO CAN ENTER A CONTEST?

FAIR FANS OF ALL AGES

and all skill levels can enter the Arts & Crafts contests.

We offer a variety of contests and categories that are age-specific or for professionals and teachers. The State Fair of Texas encourages all Fair fans to enter.



ADULT AMATEUR (18+ YRS. OF AGE)

Anyone age 18 and over, who engages in the contests subject matter as a hobby, is welcome to enter any of the categories designated in the Adult Amateur Divisions.

NOTE: Seniors compete in all Adult Amateur Divisions.

YOUTH (JUNIOR – 13 TO 17 / CHILD – 12 & YOUNGER)

The Fair has designated special categories for those ages 17 and under. Many of our contests have both a Junior Division and a Child Division to better match the skill sets of our younger contestants.

TEACHER & PROFESSIONALS

The Fair has created special categories for Fair fans whose skill level is beyond that of an amateur. Designated “Teacher & Professional” categories are for individuals who list and sell items (related to the subject matter of the contest) on a personal website, global marketing platform, or social media site. Additionally, anyone who teaches and/or instructs a particular craft or skill (related to the subject matter of the contest) should enter the designated “Teacher & Professional” categories. The Fair does not consider the amount of money earned per year related to the sales or teaching as a factor in determining contestant type.

For those entering the Canning Contest, a contestant is considered a “Teacher & Professional” if that individual has edited, produced, printed, and/or published a cookbook for professional gain. Additionally, if a contestant sells their canned goods on a personal website, global marketing platform, social media site, or in a physical store.

FINE ART

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Drawing and painting projects in a variety of mediums.

CERAMICS

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Ceramic and polymer clay projects with variety of sculpting and glazing techniques.

DESIGNER CRAFTSMAN

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Wood working, leathercraft, jewelry, stained glass, scrapbooking, mosaic tile, and textile projects.

DOLLS

(ADULT AMATEUR/JUNIOR, CHILD)
Collectable and hand-crafted dolls, bears and animals.
Dollhouses and miniatures.

CANNING

(ALL AGES COMPETE IN SAME DIVISION)
Canned vegetables, fruit, preserves, marmalades, jellies, jams, butters, pickles, and relish.

HOBBY COLLECTIONS

(ADULT AMATEUR)
Collections of only two items, 30-year-old+, non-identical items or one antique item 100 years old or more.

HOLIDAY CORNER

(ALL AGES COMPETE IN SAME DIVISION)
Seasonal and holiday decorations.

HOW ARE ENTRIES JUDGED?

Entries are judged against entries within the same category based on individual merit. 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, and Honorable Mention ribbons are awarded to the top entries in each category of every contest.

WINNING ENTRIES ARE ANNOUNCED IN LATE AUGUST AND ENTRIES WILL BE ON DISPLAY FOR THE DURATION OF THE FAIR.



NEEDLEPOINT, CREWEL, AND COUNTED CROSS STITCH

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Painted canvas, petit point, bargello, plastic canvas, and specialty stitch needlepoint projects.

NEEDLEWORK AND SEWING

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Crochet, knitting, bobbin lace, smocking, and sewing machine projects.

AFGHAN, RUGS, QUILTS, AND BEDSPREADS

(ADULT AMATEUR, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Afghans, quilts and quilted accessories, bedspreads, and rugs.

PHOTOGRAPHY

(ADULT AMATEUR, TEACHER & PROFESSIONAL, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Black & white and color photography featuring a variety of subjects.

SCALE MODEL

(ADULT AMATEUR, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Kit, kit conversion, scratch-built models, Legos®, and diorama projects

GLUE-A-SHOE

(ADULT AMATEUR, JUNIOR/CHILD)
Funny, witty diorama or sculpture using one shoe.

GREAT PUMPKIN CHALLENGE

(ADULT AMATEUR, JUNIOR, CHILD)
Decorated artificial pumpkins in Halloween and State Fair-themes.

BEST OF SHOW

The Best of Show award recognizes each contest's highest scoring entry out of all categories in an age division. Some contests, divisions, or categories may not be eligible for Best of Show and will be noted in the contest rules.

DIRECTOR'S AWARD

The Director of Creative Arts Department will select one entry representing the superior craftsmanship and creativity from all the Arts & Crafts entries. The Director's Award recipient will receive a \$750 award, and the entry will be prominently displayed during the Fair.

★ THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ★ ENTERING A CONTEST

All entries in the Arts & Craft contests should follow these general rules. Each contest has its own set of rules and guidelines to the number of entries allowed.

- Entries in the Arts & Crafts contests must be appropriate for family viewing at the Fair.
- Any entry that previously won a ribbon in a State Fair contest may not be re-entered.
- All handmade entries must be made by only the participant, unless entered into a two-person or group category as specified.
- Entries that contain edible components are prohibited except for the Canning Contest.
- The State Fair of Texas does not accept soiled, damaged, or broken items.
- Contestants must adhere to the age and skill divisions. If an entry is to be found in violation of the policy, it will be disqualified.

Security

For entries waiting to be judged and those on display during the run of the Fair, the State Fair of Texas provides building security and surveillance around the clock, and every precaution is taken to protect all entered items. Any additional insurance or security deemed necessary by the contestant must be provided by that individual.

Submitting Your Entry

Contestants must register their items online at BigTex.com/Creative. Entries can be hand delivered to the fairgrounds, or mailed to the Creative Arts Department.

Hand-Delivered Entries

The Fair will accept entries for three days in the beginning of August as outlined on the key dates. The map shows directions to the Creative Arts Building and parking information.

Non-winning entries will be picked up prior to the Fair on the designated days. Winning entries will be on display for the duration of the Fair and picked up on the designated days following the Fair.

Mail-In Entries

All entries **MUST** arrive before the entry deadline (July 29) and must include:

- Copy of registration confirmation.
- Return postage either in the form of prepaid postage, check, or money order.

Entries winning and non-winning will be returned no later than three weeks after the closing of the Fair.

Adult and Junior Divisions – **Maximum of six (6) categories**, with one (1) entry per category.

Child Division – **Maximum of two (2) entries**, only one (1) entry per category.

Each contest category will award first, second, third, and honorable mention.

One Best of Show will be awarded per age division.

FINE ART - CONTEST RULES



All entries in this contest **MUST** adhere to the rules below. Any entry in violation will not be accepted for judging.

CONTEST DESCRIPTION

This contest includes the following: **1) Drawings** – includes colored pencil, charcoal, graphite, chalk pastel, oil pastel, or scratch; **2) Paintings** – includes acrylic, oil, or water media; and **3) Mixed Media** – includes a combination of two or more of any of the above mediums.

ENTRY COMPLETION DATE

Entries must be completed after **September 1, 2023**.

SIZE REQUIREMENT

- Entry item must be minimum size 8" x 10" to a maximum of 36" x 36" and not weigh over 25 lbs., exception: miniatures.
 - Miniatures must be a minimum size of 2" x 5" to a maximum size of 5" x 5". Must be framed or mounted on a mat board.
- No abstract allowed.

PROHIBITED ENTRIES

Entries will not be accepted if they are:

- Framed glass of any kind. The entry may use plexiglass, clear plastic, or no covering.
- Digital Art.
- Artwork that is not completely dry.
- Artwork with embellishments.

FINE ART – REQUIREMENTS



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entries or entry for this department must be a drawing or painting with no embellishments.

- Artwork must be appropriate for family viewing.
- **Artwork must be completely dry** – no wet paint.
- **All entries must be framed without glass, except wrapped canvas.**
- All entries on paper must be framed without glass.
- **Must have a wire or saw tooth hanger and be ready for hanging or will not be accepted.**
- Contestant's first and last name, phone number, and category entered must be listed on the back of EACH entry.

Entries must be the work of the contestant and must have been completed after September 1, 2023.

ENTRY COMPLETION DATE

Entries must be completed after **September 1, 2023**.

SIZE REQUIREMENT

- The size of the entry must not exceed 18" x 18" x 18" in size and must not weigh over 5 lbs. unless noted in category details.

PROHIBITED ENTRIES

Entries will not be accepted if they are:

- Broken or damaged items.

This contest features works in all fine craft media, which includes sculptural and decorative works in fiber, glass, jewelry, metal, paper, textiles, leather, scrapbooking, stained glass, wood, and many other media forms of art.

ENTRY COMPLETION DATE

Entries must be completed after **September 1, 2023**.

SIZE REQUIREMENT

- The entry size must not exceed 36" x 36" x 36" in size and must not weigh over 20 lbs. unless noted in the category details.

PROHIBITED ENTRIES

Entries will not be accepted if they are:

- Kits.
- Concrete Items.
- Broken or damaged items.

DESIGNER CRAFTSMAN – REQUIREMENTS



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Entries must be appropriate for family viewing.
- Hanging items (including stained glass, wood, and mosaic) must be sturdily equipped with proper hangers, chains, and screws.
- Judging is based on the quality of workmanship and originality of design.

Entries must be the work of the contestant and must have been completed after September 1, 2023.

ASSEMBLAGE: An artistic composition made from scraps, junk, odds, and ends (such as paper, cloth, wood, stone, or metal). Usually three-dimensional.

COLLAGE: An artistic composition of various materials (such as paper, cloth, or wood) glued on a picture surface.

ENCAUSTIC PAINTING: Hot wax painting involves using heated beeswax to which colored pigments are added. The liquid or paste is then applied to a surface – usually prepared wood, though canvas and other materials are often used.

FINE ART: A visual art considered to have been created primarily for aesthetics and judged for its beauty and meaningfulness, specifically painting, drawing, watercolor, etc.

FOLK ART: Rooted in traditions that come from community and culture – expressing cultural identity by conveying shared community values and aesthetics. It encompasses a range of utilitarian and decorative media, including cloth, wood, paper, clay, metal, and more.
