

State Fair of Texas Rodeo Parking Instructions

Rodeo Participants with a Trailer

Make sure you allow PLENTY of time to get through Dallas traffic and to get to the grounds!

1. You need to go to **Gate 16**. The address to that gate is: **4900 Boxwood Street, Dallas, Texas 75223**
2. You will need to have your Rodeo Lot pass, so the gate personnel know where to direct you.
3. They will send you up the road and over the train tracks.
4. You will proceed past the white tent and through the fenced off roadway by the Tram Station. It looks like a small “alley” between the tram station and parking spaces. Please watch out for pedestrians.
5. When you reach the silver Air Stream trailer, they will check your Coggins and health papers (for out of state horses).
 - a. Gates personnel will direct you out of the line and over to your right to the Rodeo Lot and help you get parked. The lot is a tight squeeze on rodeo nights. Please be mindful of that when parking.
 - b. If you are coming in early to unload and drop your trailer for an extended period of time (i.e., for the duration of the UPRA Finals) Then the gate personnel will direct you to the left to unload your horses, feed, etc. in the barn.
 - i. When unloading, you will be sent through gate 12 and around Cattle Barn 2 and between the horse barn and the cattle barns.
 - ii. We need to be quick so please unload quickly! When leaving, you will go around the cattle barn (two right turns) and back through gate 12.
 - iii. From there you can either park in the rodeo lot or park your trailer out by gate 16.
6. **No trailers can be left in the rodeo lot over night!!**

Rodeo Participants NOT Pulling a Trailer

1. Contestants not pulling a trailer do not have to go through gate 16. You can go straight to the rodeo lot.
2. The address to the Rodeo Lot is on the back of the Rodeo lot pass. The Address is: **1500 Bank Street, Dallas, Texas 75223**
3. Turn off South Haskell Ave. on to Bank Street and it will T into the Rodeo lot. You must have your parking tag to park in that lot.
