## NOMINATION FORM

Volumes have been written about pioneers who pushed beyond the existing frontier to lay claim to the vast wilderness that was Texas. The Texas Heritage Hall of Honor recognizes men and women who have made significant contributions to the agricultural heritage of Texas. They have made their marks as farmers, ranchers, drovers, inventors, innovators, educators, authors, legislators, and preservationists. Their achievements span 170 years, reaching back to the birth of the Texas Republic and extending out into a limitless future. Considered annually, both living and deceased nominees are eligible to be inducted into the Heritage Hall of Honor. Nominees will be evaluated based on their lifetime achievements and their sustained contributions in one of the four following areas:

## TO BE CONSIDERED FOR INDUCTION INTO THE TEXAS HERITAGE HALL OF HONOR, NOMINEES MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING:

- Minimum of 30 years of sustained leadership or service in the Texas agriculture industry.
- A record of lasting contributions that have benefited communities, institutions, or individuals in Texas agriculture.
- Demonstrated integrity, professionalism, and commitment to service.
- Has a reputation for mentorship, collaboration, and positive influence on the future of Texas agriculture.

## SUBMISSION CHECKLIST:

- Completed Nomination Form
- A one-to-two-page nomination letter summarizing the nominee's qualifications.
- One letter of support is required, with the option to submit up to three.
- Optional: resume, news articles, awards, or other supporting materials (Maximum six pages total of material).
