BEFORE YOU LOAD UP AND HEAD TO THE FAIR, CHECK THE LATEST NEW WORLD SCREW WORM MOVEMENT GUIDANCE FOR ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS. THIS SIMPLE GUIDE WILL HELP YOU DETERMINE WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO SHOW.

APPLICABLE GUIDANCE

Section 1.10 – Exhibition “Show” Livestock

Originating from an Infested Zone (IZ) > Exhibition “Show” Livestock

Exhibition “Show” livestock includes cattle, sheep, goats, swine, and exotic livestock moving to or from a fair, livestock show, exposition, jackpot, or similar event. Exhibition “Show” Livestock does not include poultry or livestock used in rodeo events. For rodeo livestock movement requirements, see applicable movement sections/requirements for specific origin and destination scenarios.

At the Premises of Origin

- Livestock must:
 1. Receive an enhanced inspection by a NWS Certified Inspector or veterinarian,
 2. Be officially identified, and
 3. Issued a NWS Treatment/Movement Certificate.
- Livestock may move to multiple premises inside or outside of NWS Infested Zones as long as the livestock return to the premises of origin **within 14 days** of the inspection date **unless slaughtered**.

APPLICABLE GUIDANCE

Section 2.9 – Exhibition “Show” Livestock

Originating from OUTSIDE an Infested Zone (IZ) > Exhibition “Show” Livestock

Exhibition “Show” livestock includes cattle, sheep, goats, swine, and exotic livestock moving to or from a fair, livestock show, exposition, jackpot, or similar event. Exhibition “Show” Livestock excludes poultry or livestock used in rodeo events. For rodeo livestock movement requirements see applicable movement sections/requirements for specific origin and destination scenarios.

At the Premises of Origin

No specific New World Screwworm (NWS) movement requirements.

At the Livestock Show before returning to the Premises of Origin:

- Livestock remaining at a livestock show **INSIDE** a NWS Infested Zone for more than 24 hours must be:
 1. Inspected,
 2. Officially identified, and
 3. Issued a New World Screwworm (NWS) Treatment/Movement Certificate.
- Preventive treatment is **not** required for movements.
- Any livestock found to be infested must be treated and free of myiasis prior to movement. Each case will be handled individually based on epidemiological factors.
- Livestock shows must provide NWS Certified Inspectors to perform inspections of animals that remain at the livestock show for more than 24 hours.
- Livestock remaining at a livestock show **INSIDE** a NWS Infested Zone for less than 24 hours:
 - No specific New World Screwworm (NWS) movement requirements.
- Livestock show **OUTSIDE** a NWS Infested Zone:
 - No specific New World Screwworm (NWS) movement requirements.

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NOT COMING FROM AN INFESTED ZONE?

If your livestock are not subject to additional New World Screwworm movement requirements, **simply follow the animal health requirements outlined in the State Fair of Texas Exhibitor Handbook for your species.**
